Since 2003, the European year of persons with disabilities, national exhibitions of specialized enterprises and cooperatives of persons with disabilities have been organized in Bulgaria. On the occasion of the United Nations' International Year of Co-operatives 2012 and by the initiative of the National Union of worker producers co-operatives, National Federation of employers of persons with disabilities and our colleagues in the disability and social sector, the "Tenth Jubilee Exhibition" grew into the "First European Fair of Social Enterprises and Cooperatives of Persons with Disabilities", which took place at the International Fair in Ploydiy, from 29th March to 1st April 2012.

The event took place thanks to the support of the European Commission and was one of the biggest events inaugurated by H.E. László Andor, EU Commissioner for Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion, within the framework of the International Year of Cooperatives.
